

## CHATEAU PESQUIE



Pioneers of the Ventoux, the Chaudiere family bought Chateau Pesquie prior to the creation of the appellation and undertook a complete replanting and upgrading of their vineyards. Although the Chateau Pesquie vineyards are situated in the southern Rhone Valley on the same latitude as Cheateauneuf du Pape, the altitude and cooler temperatures of Mont Ventoux lend the terroir more northern characteristics of texture and finesse.

A testament to third generation Alex and Fred's incredible attention to detail, "Terrasses" is consistently regarded as one of the Rhone Valley's greatest value wines.

### REGION

Estate vineyards are located on the southern slopes of Mount Ventoux and are blessed with outstanding levels of sunshine (up to 12 hours per day in July). The terroir has a great mineral diversity, predominantly consisting of limestone. Château Pesquié has one of the coolest microclimates in the south of the Rhône Valley, due to elevation (between 300 and 400 m) and the influence of the mountain. The variation of temperatures between days and nights helps create excellent physiological balance in the vines, and colour, concentration and freshness in the wines. The Mistral ventilates, ensuring the cultivation of healthy vines.
