

VINI STOCCO



Located in Bicinicco in the heart of Friuli-Grave, the Stocco family farm is a wonderfully traditional place that was founded in 1910 by Francesco Stocco.

Andrea, Checo's great-grandson now makes the wine and his sister Paola runs the Agriturismo, producing preserves from the different grapes grown in their vineyards. A fourth generation winemaker, Andrea is meticulous and talented, producing wines that are always text book expressions of each grape variety, pure and precise in the glass.

REGION

Friuli-Venezia Giulia is the fourth smallest region in Italy, but in this small space it somehow manages to produce some of the most amazing white wines in Italy, and is now beginning to produce some equally splendid reds. The limited production capacity, however, means that many of these wonderful wines are hard to obtain outside the region.

The largest wine producing area in Friuli is Grave del Friuli, located in the center of Pordonone and Udine. Located on alluvial plains, the soil of this region is composed of gravel and red sand, known as 'grave', just as in the Bordeaux region of the same name. Not surprisingly, Merlot finds one of its greatest homes here.
